Your quarterly statements from LPL Financial provide a clear, comprehensive view of your investments and account activity.

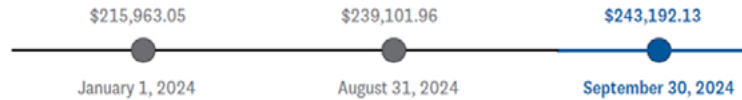
Inside each statement, you'll find:

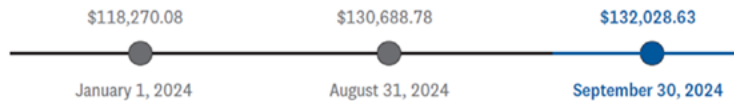
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Portfolio Accounts

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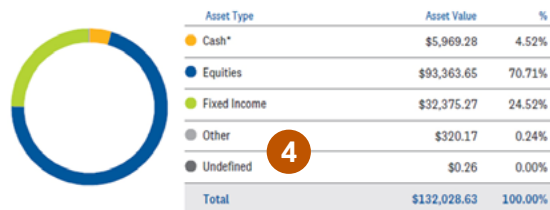

Change in Value Timeline

Asset Allocation

Shows the breakdown of assets in your account based on underlying holdings, providing a view of your investment exposure. It includes information about the amount of cash held as liquid cash and equivalents.

- The chart uses “X-ray” technology to look inside holdings like ETFs and Mutual Funds, and also looks at the asset classes of the underlying securities within funds to show a more meaningful asset allocation. Note that the values shown here are representative of an X-ray analysis and will likely not match the balances shown in the holdings section. For example, the chart calculates the balance invested in equities directly held and held within funds. The holding sections further down on the statement display holdings within security types (e.g., equities, mutual funds).

4

Other and Undefined

- Other values indicate a holding or portion of a holding in a security type that is not widely held, such as precious metals.
- Undefined represents a holding or portion of a holding that is not defined by LPL’s data provider. We continuously improve this information, so the slice of the chart for undefined will decrease over time.

1 Mutual Funds, Publicly Traded Funds and Interval Funds
Displays totals for each asset type, providing a clear view of your investment mix.

2 Cost Basis and Unrealized Gain/Loss

- Cost basis is the money invested in that particular holding. Any purchase of additional shares or units will increase the cost basis, including shares that are acquired via dividend reinvestment.
- Unrealized gain/loss is the difference between the holding's market value and its cost basis.

3 Purchase Cost and Investment Gain/Loss

- Purchase cost represents only the cost of the shares or units directly purchased in this account. Shares or units acquired via dividend reinvestment do not add to the purchase cost.
- Investment gain/loss is the difference between the holding's market value and its purchase cost. Because the cost of reinvested dividends is not included in purchase cost, investment gain/loss will be different than unrealized gain/loss due to the income generated by the security. For holdings that produce income that's reinvested, purchase cost and investment gain/loss can be a better indicator of the performance of the holding.

Additional sections may appear as part of the account holdings summary, such as equities and options, corporate bonds, government and agency bonds, private label collateralized mortgage obligations and mortgage-backed securities, municipal bonds, structured products, certificates of deposit, unit investment trusts, rights and warrants, other securities, and account holdings not held at LPL Financial.
